1647 ELI⁶ TYLER (Stephen⁵) born Buckland MA 20 May 1793 and died Newfane VT 31 Aug. 1877. Married Freelove Ledyard daughter of Charles and Phebe (Hale) Ledyard of Winhall VT. She born Winhall VT (Bennington Co.) 14 Oct. 1800 and died 28 Aug. 1878. She and Eli buried Newfane's Williamsville Cemetery. Charles Ledyard was born of French parents in Port Royal, Acadia (now Nova Scotia) 11 Oct. 1746 and died Winhall 1835. He and his family along with many other French were exiled to the colonies (in this case Connecticut) by the British in 1755. He served in the Revolutionary War from that state and married in Bristol CT 15 Aug. 1776. He moved to VT about 1795.

3669 Charles E. ⁷Tyler (Eli⁶) born 13 Nov 1834 and died Newfane VT 6 Apr. 1903 and buried in that town's Williamsville Cemetery. Never married and had a teamster and butchering business in Newfane. Was his parent's caretaker in their later years. In his 1903 will he kindly remembers the 2 surviving daughters (Phebe M. Chase) and Nellie J. Wheeler) of his deceased brother Stephen and the grandsons of deceased brother Lewis.

3670 LewisA. ⁷Tyler (Eli⁶) born Wilmington VT c. 1836 (date of birth established by 1850 census where he was 14 and 1858 marriage record where he is 22). Married Marcia Rosalie (Russell) Johnson in Rockingham VT 17 Oct 1858. She was widowed in 1857 and left with 5 children. Lewis was a private in Co. "B" 6th VT Vols and was mortally wounded at the Battle of Winchester VA 19 Sept. 1864. He died in the Army hospital there 4 Oct. 1864. Marcia married 3rd William Bliss in 1865 and had 5 more children. Tyler children born Wardsboro VT –

(1842-1915) and Florence Carman (1843-1918) who came to USA in 1880 and in the Minneapolis census of 1910 their widowed daughter "May" Tyler with sons Charles R. and Edward D. Tyler are living with them along with Carman's son, Robert age 40. Charles M. was a chef/cook by trade and was in the mining town of Anaconda, Montana in 1900 and 1901 without his family. He died in Hinsdale, Cheshire Co. NH 25 Dec. 1904 at the home of one of his half brothers or half sisters. Burial was Williamsville Cemetery in Newfane VT and Florence was executrix of the estate.
